In 2004 my & my son's poultry farm, consisting of eight houses, suffered catastrophic damage by lightning, I lost nearly an entire house full of birds!

My insurance adjuster, Jim Griggs, contacted the representative for Surge Suppression Incorporated (Dan Ledford) in Dothan Alabama and asked him to contact me. Since his first visit to my poultry farm, Mr. Ledford has been very helpful to me by making sure I understand the electrical issues I and other poultry farmers face.


To date, the surge suppression equipment Mr. Ledford recommended has been installed in all eight houses. I am in the process of getting my generators houses protected as well.

Though I have not had any lightning strikes, I now understand that I was getting transient voltage surges daily all over my farm. The evidence for that, and that the surge suppression equipment is doing its job is this: *As of the writing of this recommendation, I am three weeks into a new flock of birds. By now. I should have had to replace at least 20 or more light bulbs in my houses. I have only needed to replace 2. These surge suppression units are working and working well.*

I am confident that I am protected from any future lightning strikes and from the damaging effects of transient voltage surges. Bottom line... more profits!
